

## ALGAE TREATMENT GUIDE

### 1 ASCERTAIN THE TYPE OF ALGAE

**GREENWATER ALGAE** is microscopic and causes the water to look like green cordial or pea soup. The algae is often so small it is impossible to filter from the pond water.

**BLANKETWEED** looks like green cotton wool and floats on the surface. Another variety may also proliferate in water courses and streams as “slime”, and sometimes on the pond walls.

### 2 TREAT THE ALGAE ACCORDING TO THE TABLE BELOW

Use the preventative treatments as suggested, to reduce further outbreaks. Note: If the pH of the pond water is high, treatments will not be as effective.

#### GREEN WATER ALGAE

##### TREATMENT OPTION:

Check pH with: [pH Test Kit](#), and if high

Adjust with: [PondPro® pH ADJUST DOWN](#)

Then Treat with: [PondPro® Green Away](#)

Followed by [PondPro® Sludge Away](#) (to consume dead algae)

##### PREVENT FURTHER OUTBREAKS WITH:

[PondPro® Extract of Barley Straw](#) with Clarifier Bacteria

OR Install a Biofilter & U.V. Clarifier for long term prevention

#### BLANKETWEED

##### TREATMENT OPTION:

First: Physically remove as much as possible

Check pH with: [pH Test Kit](#), and if high

Adjust with: [PondPro® pH ADJUST DOWN](#)

Then Use: String Algae Treatment
